



Calling instructions pregnancy childbirth

COMMON

CALL IN THE EVENT OF:



A childbirth that occurs between 37 and 42 weeks

Labour term



- Before 37 weeks' pregnancy term:
- Loss of amniotic fluid
- Cramps or prelabour that are regular and/or painful




- Less than during menstruation
- · Clear red or brownish

Blood loss



- Greater amount of blood loss than during menstruation
- Blood clots





 Follow the instructions of your midwife care worker for calling Amniotic fluid - colour



- Green or brown colour
- Call when you first observe this colour, during the day or in the night



Head of the baby descends into the pelvis

Amniotic fluid and descent of the baby



Call if during the last check-up the head has not properly descended and your water breaks

- Irregular
- The contraction does not last longer than 40 - 60 seconds
- The time between contractions is longer than 4 – 5 minutes

Contractions



4 5

- Regular pattern for 1 hour and
- The contraction is longer than 40 - 60 seconds
- The time between contractions is less than 4 5 minutes
- If this is not your first time for giving birth, call in the event of severe regular contractions
